This position provides technical expertise in the development, preservation, and safety of aviation in Minnesota. Duties include inspecting and licensing airports and commercial aviation operators; enforcing Minnesota Statutes and Rules pertaining to aeronautics; organizing and conducting safety and educational seminars for pilots and airport operators; and providing pilot services in single and multi-engine aircraft. In-state travel is required up to 50% of the time; this includes some in-state overnight travel.

- Providing consultation on aviation or airport data management for the military, the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA), a contractor for the FAA, or a state agency.

A bachelor's or master's degree in aviation or airport management may substitute for six months of professional experience.
