Scholarship Opportunity

This year, the MBAA will be awarding one (1) ATP / CTP Program in partnership with Flight Safety International. The training bridges the gap between the knowledge of the commercial pilot and that which is expected of an ATP certificate holder, specifically in the areas of aerodynamics, automation, adverse weather conditions, turbine engines, and transport airplane performance. The pilot will become familiar with recognizing, avoiding, and recovering from errors which can occur when operating turbine-powered transport category airplanes in a complex and dynamic environment. The recipient should plan on attending the award presentation in August 2022.

Scholarship Eligibility and Requirements:

- Completed '2022 Scholarship Cover Letter' (found on the MBAA scholarship website)
- Copy of your current resume
- Copy of official transcript from current/previous college or university
- Copies of all FAA ratings or certificates held (if applicable)
- Commercial Pilot Certificate, Instrument and Multi-Engine Ratings
- A 250 to 500-word essay describing the applicant's previous background, current involvement, and demonstration of their commitment to pursuing a professional career in business aviation.
- A letter of recommendation from a member of the aviation department faculty (for students) or relevant professional contact. (Other than relatives or students)
- Preference will be given towards Minnesota residents/students followed by that of surrounding states.
- Scholarship applicants will be interviewed (by phone or in person) by representatives of the MBAA no later than July 22, 2022.
